Lessons Learned: We need to instruct our radio operators, that if they are at a water/food location, that they need to remind the staff to let us know when they need additional supplies way ahead of actually running out since it takes some time to transport it. If a person requests medical or other assistance at a radio position, the radio operator should keep that person at that location until help can reach it.
